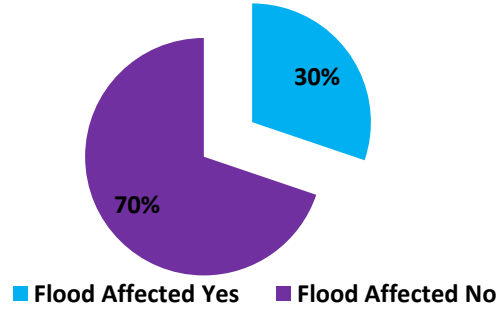

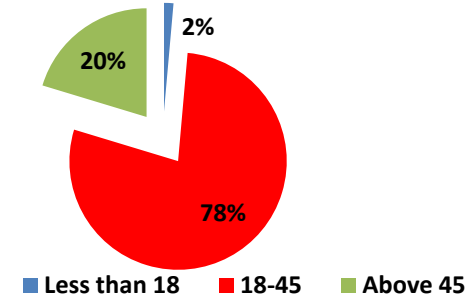

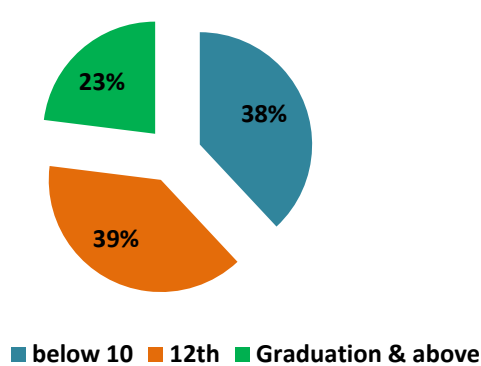

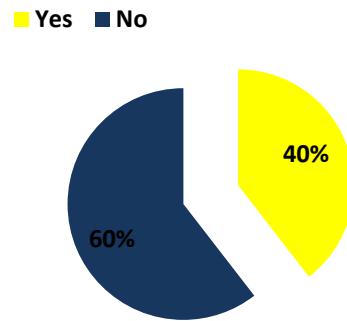

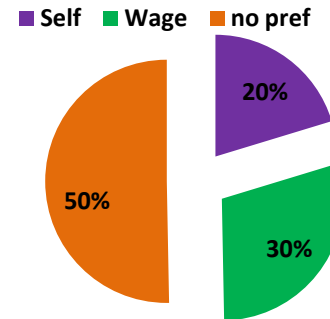

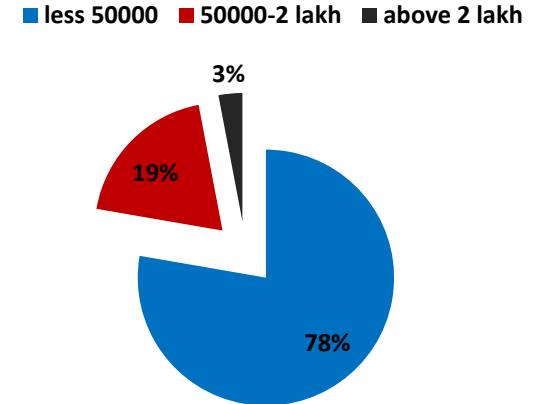

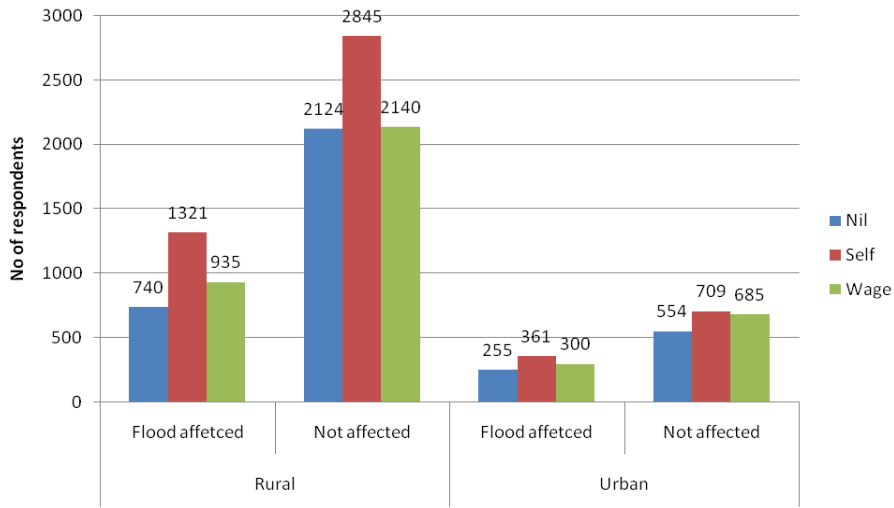

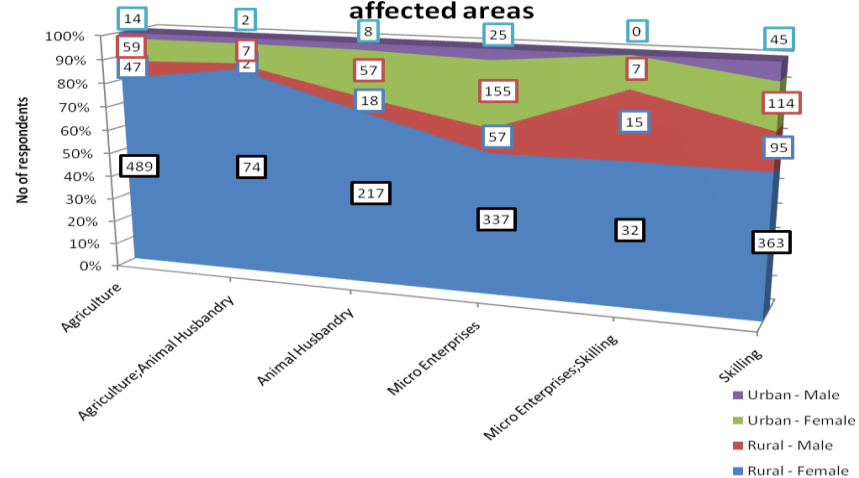

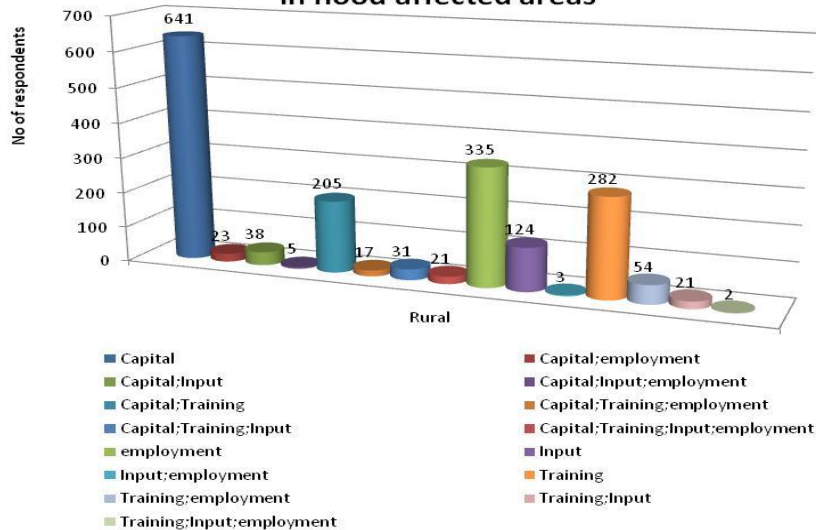
Preferred employment



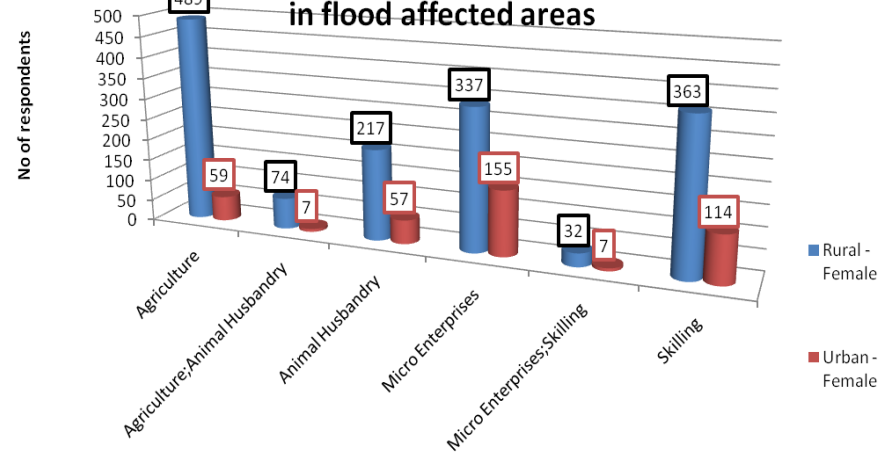
Preferred sector by unemployed respondents in flood affected areas



Support needed by unemployed rural respondents in flood affected areas

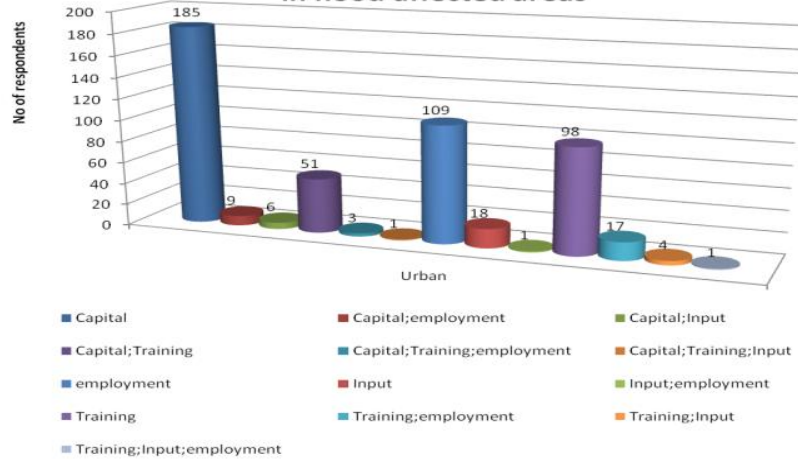


Preferred sector by unemployed female respondents in flood affected areas

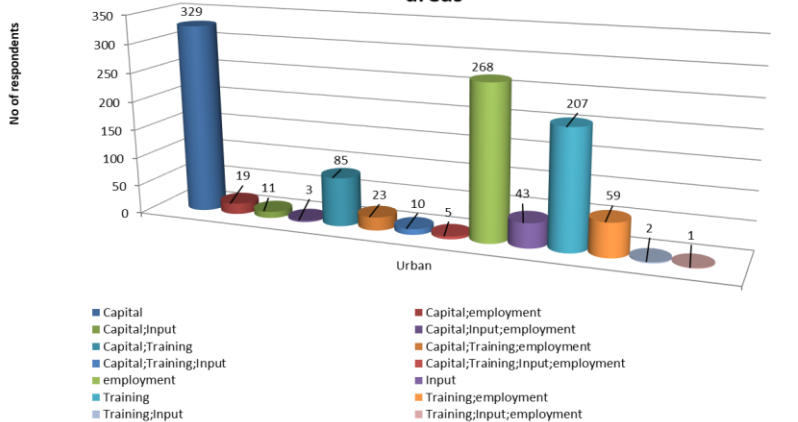


Sector wise requirement

Inferences

- **Out of the 1746 flood affected unemployed rural respondents surveyed, 49% prefers primary sector to earn livelihoods whereas 26% prefers to get skilled to get wage employment and 25% wishes to pursue entrepreneurship as a livelihood activity.**
- **The Interest pattern exhibits similarity in women only survey population in the same category.**
- **37.9% of the flood affected urban unemployed population wish to turn towards entrepreneurship, 32.3% seeks to acquire new skills to gain wage employment and the rest (29.8%) identifies primary sector as their preferred income generation activity.**
- **Whereas the majority of the urban women population (40%) surveyed wishes to turn to entrepreneurship and affinity towards the other field gets equal shares of interests.**
