

## **Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM)**

DAY NULM aims to reduce the poverty and vulnerability of the urban poor households by enabling them to access gainful self employment and skilled wage employment opportunities. The mission would aim at providing shelters equipped with essential services to the urban homeless and also address the livelihood concerns of the urban street vendors. With this aim CMMU have undergone my services in Palakkad, Cherpulassery and Mannarkkad ULBs

### **Social Mobilization & Institutional Development (SM&ID)**

In this component 350 NHGs were formed and it includes almost 6000 families including Elderly, PWD and Transgender NHGs and also revived 20 inactive NHGs. As a financial support and to make livelihood to urban poor of NHGs Revolving Fund of Rs.5320000/- were distributed to 532 NHGs with Rs.10000/- each, whereas Rs.2200000/- were distributed to 44 ALF as Revolving Fund for the same purpose. For performed various tasks and an income for CLF Rs. 9552100/- were distributed.

### **Self Employment Program (SEP)**

This component provides financial assistance for setting gainful enterprises. Under this 253 beneficiaries have undergone Entrepreneurship Development Program and 131 among them were started their own enterprises including Urban ME, Individual and Group enterprises. 838 NHGs were supported with Linkage Loan with an amount of Rs.434307900/- which is used for livelihood as well as for personal purposes.

### **Employment through Skill Training and Placement (EST&P)**

This component focus to provide skills to the unskilled and to upgrade the existing skills. Under this 166 beneficiaries were trained and placed 67 beneficiaries. As part of financial support travelling allowances were provided for 74 beneficiaries were provided with an amount of Rs. 170333/- and Post Placement Support was provided to 14 beneficiaries with an amount of Rs. 45000/-

## **Support to Urban Street Vendors (SUSV)**

Under this component a third party survey was conducted during the period of 2017 and identified 725 street vendors and which was approved by the Town Vending Committee and those identified street vendors were provided with ID cards. In order to organize them the process of developing vending markets are in progress.

## **Scheme of Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH)**

Under this component 83 homeless very identified and to make them accommodate in the shelters a project of 250 crores were submitted and gets approval from the State Level Sanction Committee. For the construction of Shelters the ULB has awarded the work to an accredited agency and also Technical sanctions were gathered for the construction. The process for starting the construction works is under progress.

## **Innovative and Special Projects**

Under this innovative enterprises like Day Care, Housekeeping, Urban Service Team, Santwanam units, Harsham units and also Café Corners were started in ULBs with the support of NHG members. For selling the products through online various products were forwarded to Amazon Saheli. Medical camps for the NHG members were conducted with the support from National Health Mission and got treatment for nearby 300 beneficiaries from various NHGs. For those beneficiaries of NHGs who have no gas connection CMMU able to distribute 52 gas connections with the help of Ujwala Yojana.
