All DMCs and ADMCs from 14 districts participated in the review meeting. A review cum discussion of the major agricultural activities was conducted in the for noon session of 26th. The following decisions were taken regarding the ongoing schemes and upcoming projects.

| Sl No | Programme | Decisions/ Actions |

| 1 | Bhakshya Suraksha Bhavanam | State average achievement as of now is 64%. Maximum should be attained in March 18 so as to elevate the total achievement % of the programme, especially those districts who scored below 50% till date. |
| 2 | Nattuchantha | 1. In march 2018, ME products need be introduced in every market held. 2. 100% geographical expansion of weekly markets is being contemplated for next year. |
| 3 | Organic farming | Organic farming with certified products either PGS or Illrd party certification is a thrust area. Lands with contiguous possession of more than 3 years are necessary for this. These lands need to be identified before the start of next year itself. |
| 4 | Plant nurseries | 140 plant nurseries will be established in 14 districts. This target needs suitable lands of appropriate sizes and road access. These should be identified in March 2018. |
| 5 | Farm producer organizations | Establishment of FPOs on various products is another central theme. Details of identified 17 FPOs for NABARD promotional incentive already requested via mail. Respond to this immediately |
| 6 | Passion fruit | Passion fruit cultivation will be taken up during the next |

| 7 | SARANSH 2018 | The state level competition Saransh is on 17 th March. Pls SEE that Livelihoods theme gets due importance in the presentations of your district. |
