Major Decisions

- Alappuzha, Kannur and Idukki district complete the revisit of Snehitha Calling Bell Support recipients at the earliest and submit the revisit report and need assessment report by 15th December.
- Complete the formation and first level Orientation training of Rangasree team in Kozhikode District before December 25th.
- Give list of 3 Women writers from each district to state Mission before December 30th 2018.
- Provide Livelihood training to Snehitha Inmates and ensure that they start the livelihood activity or enterprises.
- Complete Secondary data collection in Women friendly Panchayath
- Ensure the ownership of CDS in Snehitha Calling Bell programme

- Continuous support to the identified support recipients of Calling Bell based on their demand
- Develop a model gender resource centre in every district and streamline GRC activities
- Take initiative to get fund for Rangasree team from District Panchayath
- Initiation to provide sustainable livelihood support for Snehitha Inmates
- Find out 3 person from each district who were interested and capable in writing for the formation of a literature group
- Provide gender sensitization training to other departments/officials using resource pool
- Complete the NHG facilitators training for Gender self learning programme
- Get fund from LSGIs for gender development activities
- Provide livelihood to at least 25% of the snehitha inmates
- Create CDS level committee for vigilant group
