Approach

- Addressing tribal communities as an outlier of Kerala's development experience
 - Kudumbashree's core strategies in tribal sector
 - Community based approach
 - Focus on PVTG and other vulnerable communities
- Started as special intervention programme in 2007 with funds from STDD
