**EoI for Submission of Project Proposals for imparting Non-domain skills Training for candidates who have completed Domain training under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY)-Kerala**

KUDUMBASHREE, State Poverty Eradication Mission is implementing DDUGKY in Kerala. Kudumbashree invites applications from the interested Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs) working under DDU-GKY project in Kerala to allot the target of skilling 39 rural youth in Non-domain curriculum (Soft Skills, English and IT), who have completed domain training in Fire and Rescue Operator – (FRS202) from a DDU GKY empanelled agency, who have winded-up the training centre halfway. **Interested PIAs currently working under DDU-GKY Project in Kerala can submit the application to Kudumbashree Head Office on or before 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2019.** The PIA may also implement the project as consortium model (Placement can be done through consortium partner). The target may be treated as additional target to PIA or may be reduced from the existing target as per the viability of the project. The selected PIA will be immediately issued Sanction Order for training candidates (residential training only) in the following Non-domain hours and OJT:

PIA should also ensure the placement of candidates in Fire & Safety Sector with minimum salary of Rs. 8000/- per month. Cost of training can be proposed by the PIA as per the existing DDU GKY cost norms which will be finalized by SRLM based on the feasibility of running a training centre. OJT, Placement and assessment for the candidate have to be ensured by the PIA. All other cost excluding domain class room training hours may be met as per the SOP common cost norms and guideline. As this is a special case and students have gone through considerable mental agony an additional incentive for placement may be proposed by the PIA to ensure 80% to 100% placement. Fifty percent of the fund will be released during the time of MoU signing. The Balance fifty percent will be released after verification of placements done by the PIA. The State has the right to cancel, amend the provisions of the EOI. The PIA has to follow all provisions of SoP (Standard Operating Procedure) of DDUGKY.

Detailed proposal (Hard copy only) to be send to Executive Director, Kudumbashree on or before 30<sup>th</sup> August 2019 and the internal committee of Kudumbashree shall perform the screening based on placement tie-ups with the industry and prior performance under DDU GKY and the eligible proposal shall be submitted to PAC (Project ApproPval Committee) for final approval.
