We decided to have an in house software team, when we realised that only an in house team can bring efficiency and accuracy with continuous support at a lower cost. Based on this realisation, we formed a software team during this financial year.

Ms. S. Meghna, who has 13 years work experience (8 years experience in IT field) is the project leader of our software team. Ms. S.Surabhi who has 6 years experience in this field and Mr. R. Nithin who has 3 years work experience are the team members. In the first phase, needs for software development was identified from among the various teams of Kudumbashree. We asked our team on what all softwares are needed to improve monitoring of respective various projects. Our teams submitted the software requirements and gave briefing to the development team. Following that, within the last six months, our software team has developed 8 softwares. Now, they are developing 6 more softwares.

The list of the completed softwares are as follows:

1. Software for grading Neighbourhood groups (NHG), Area Development Societies (ADS), which are federation of NHGs and Community Development Societies (CDS), which are federation of ADSs.
2. Software for monitoring the Resurgent Kerala Loan Scheme (RKLS), which was availed by many CDSs after the floods.
3. Software for expenditure monitoring and reporting of Destitute Free Kerala (DFK) project, which was started envisaging at creating a destitute free state.
4. The software for tracking the area incentive given to the farming groups through Mahila Kisan Sashaktikaran Pariyojana (MKSP), which is being implemented through Kudumbashree
5. Online Registration of the Saras Fairs, which is organised by Kudumbashree twice a year.
6. Software for creating an online work appraisal system of all staffs of Kudumbashree.
7. Software for monitoring the National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM), which is being implemented through Kudumbashree.
8. Software for integration with the Local Self Government Institutions as part of Destitute Free Kerala project.

The list of softwares, development of which are progressing are as follows:

1. Software for monitoring the Revolving Fund (RF) given to ADS as a part of National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM)

2. Software for managing the sales of the Kudumbashree products being sold through Amazon Saheli of Amazon, the online marketing site.

3. Software for monitoring the Special Tribal Project being implemented through Kudumbashree.

4. A Grievance redressal software

5. Software for monitoring the skill training and placement of NULM project

6. Software for the survey of urban street vendors being implemented as part of National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM).
