

## **MINUTES OF STATE PLAN REVIEW MEETING – GENDER**

*Date: 03/08/2018*

*Venue: State Mission- Main Hall, Trivandrum*

### **Points highlighted and decision made on the basis of task assigned in last PRM**

1. Snehitha Calling Bell- Ernakulam, Kollam, Palakkad and Alapuzha District have to complete the data entry of Snehitha calling bell's support recipients details before August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
2. Category wise updation of Snehitha calling bell's support recipients has to be completed before August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
3. Vigilant group members training have to be completed in district before August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
4. Gender sensitization training for CDS chairpersons has been successfully completed in all districts. There are few district who did not achieve full strength, those district are requested make arrangements for the training of dropouts.

### **Future plan**

1. District Mission has to plan to for convergence action to address different vulnerabilities of Snehitha calling bell's support recipients
2. CBO must take ownership of the Snehitha calling bell's support recipients, District Mission team has to make convenient plan for the same and prepare a monitoring protocol for SD convenor.
3. State and District mission should prepare an inclusion plan for the Snehitha calling bell's support recipients.

4. State Mission has to conduct a high level consultation to take further action based on the findings and data of Snehitha calling bell initiatives
5. District Mission should conduct a Medical camp and start Pakalveedu with the ownership of Gramapanchayaths for Snehitha calling bell's support recipients.
6. Balasabha members should visit Snehitha calling bell's support recipients once in a month and keep a record diary.
7. DMCs must take personal initiatives and make a plan to strengthen Vigilant Groups.
8. Vigilant group members must conduct a meeting once in a month with concerned police station and turn that station into reporting point.
9. State Mission has to take a policy level decision for the future of Vigilant Group before next PRM
10. District Mission has to conduct convergent programmes with different departments and agencies (Home dept. Excise Department, Department of Fire & Rescue Service, DELSA) to enhance vigilant groups' interventions.
11. New GRC should be identified and inaugurated before next PRM.
12. Existing GRCs should be strengthened by regular visit, events, and activities.
13. All GRCs should be included in Gramapanchayath's Plan
14. Days of counselling services at GRC must be fixed.
15. One modal GRC should be started in each district.
16. Each GRC should conduct an exclusive activity once in a month.
17. BLCCC should focus on pre marital counselling.
18. District should get a work order from departments or agencies for gender sensitization training.

19. Snehitha staff should give livelihood training to inmates. Snehitha must keep a register for the inmate livelihood activities, and there should be a column in the inmate registration form asking whether they need livelihood support or not.
20. Snehitha staff has to monitor the livelihood activity of inmates as well.
21. As part of 'Harsham' pilot project Snehitha has to deal with calls from clients.

### **Challenges to DPMs which should be met before next learning day**

1. All GRCs should be included in Gramapanchayat Plan and get the details of fund allotment.
2. Conduct a medical camp through sponsorship for Snehitha calling bell's support recipients
3. Balasabha members must visit Snehitha calling bell's support recipients, and keep a record diary.
4. Take initiative to start Pakalveedu or special project under LSG for Snehitha calling bell's support recipients
5. Complete Vulnerability mapping's impact study on the basis of questionnaire
6. Design Vulnerability reduction project
