Minutes of PRM 11th June 2018

Achievements of Social Development team for DFK

- ✓ A total of 28 DFK DPRs (19 General and 9 ST) were submitted by the districts Wayanad (16), Malappuram (8), Kannur (2) and Ernakulam (2).
- ✓ Ernakulam identified 456 DFK beneficiaries for skill training.

Targets to be achieved by districts before August-PRM as presented by SAPM on 11th June

- Complete CDS and LSGI level training before 30th June – date changed to 31 August 2018.
- Submit all DPRs from districts before 31st July
- Identify beneficiaries for skill training before 31st July – date changed to 16 July 2018.
- Identify beneficiaries for MGNREGS before 31st July – date changed to 16 July 2018.

Specific targets given to districts during PRM

- ❖ **Kannur and Wayanad** should submit all DPRs **before June 30th** and enrol all identified beneficiaries who are physically able to MGNREGS.
- ❖ **Ernakulam** should send details of beneficiaries identified for skill training before **June 15th**.
- ❖ **Ernakulam, Malappuram and Kottayam** should complete health camps before June 30th and submit all DPRs before July 31st.
- ❖ **Pathanamthitta** should submit 50% of DPRs **before June 30th** and the rest before July 31st.
- ❖ **Kozhikode, Thrissur, Trivandrum, Palakkad, Idukki, Alappuzha, Kasargod and Kollam DPMs** should prepare and submit a plan for improving their status **on or before 18th June 2018**.
- ❖ **Kozhikode** should complete all Gramasabha before June 30th and submit all DPRs before July 31st.
- ❖ **Idukki and Kollam** should speed up the entire process through the District Collector and submit DPRs before July 31st.
- ❖ **Alappuzha and Palakkad** should speed up the process and submit DPRs before July 31st.
- ❖ **All DPMs** should attend the DFK meeting on **18th June 2018**.

Targets to be achieved by DPMs before 16th July 2018

Achievements of Social development team for BUDS

- ✓ All Districts published Notification for the posts of BUDS/BRC Teachers.
- ✓ Gap reports of existing BUDS institutions were submitted by all districts.
- ✓ All districts except Thiruvananthapuram, submitted case studies of two BUDS students from each district.
- ✓ All districts submitted the list of eligible teachers to be trained through SCERT.
- ✓ Renovation of BUDS School, Livelihood training, MGNREGS Convergence, Vegetable cultivation, District BUDS Training Centre, Environmental Celebration, Medical Camps, “Pravesanolsavam” were done in districts as their District Initiatives

Target to be achieved by 31st July

- The districts yet to submit the DPR of proposed BUDS institutions should submit it on or before 18th June.
- The selection procedures of the BUDS /BRC teachers in districts should be completed as per the schedule by 13/7/2018
- The district level training for BUDS/ BRC teachers, LSGI officials, representatives and CDS chairpersons should be completed before 31/7/2018
- Update the basic details of BUDS and BRC on or before 31/7/2018 (One spread sheet for Existing BUDS & BRCs and another for New BUDS institutions)
- Take initiation for registering BUDS and BRC students with NIRAMAYA insurance scheme before 31st July

Specific Target to districts given by Executive Director

- ❖ Take necessary action for starting the new BUDS institutions (2017-18-Budget). Once the fund from e-LAMS is received, districts should be ready to make the expenditure at the earliest, followed by submission of utilisation certificate to State Mission Office.
- ❖ DMCs should plan for the purchase of vehicle for BUDS institutions, as and when the direction from Government for the same is received.
- ❖ Start collecting the basic details of LSGIs for establishing the 200 BUDS institutions that was announced in the 2018-19-budget.

Targets to be achieved by DPMs before 16th July

- ✘ A detailed presentation on What, How and When for developing the identified BUDS institutions to a Model one shall be worked out and atleast one step should be taken towards its achievement.
