

REPORT ON ACHEIVEMENTS OF DAY _ NULM

CMM – RADHIKA RAMAKRISHNAN

ELOOR MUNICIPALITY

Social Mobilization and Institutional Development (SM&ID)

- 155 new women NHGs were formed in Eloor ULB and 31 elderly NHGs were formed.
- 120 NHGs were supported with Revolving Fund of 10,000 Rupees each.
- 22 ADSs were supported with Revolving Fund of 50,000 Rupees each.

Employment through Skill Training & Placement (EST&P)

EST&P focus on providing assistance for development / upgrading of the skills of the urban poor so as to enhance their capacity for self-employment and salaried employment.

- Enrolled 64 Candidates for different trainings under EST&P from Eloor ULB & of which 28 candidates got wage employment with an average monthly salary of Rs.8000.

Self-Employment Programme (SEP)

Through Self Employment Programme financial assistance to individuals /groups of urban poor for setting up gainful self-employment ventures micro-enterprises, suited to their skills, training, aptitude and local conditions

MUKULAM – BUDS SCHOOL PRODUCTS





The various products made by the physically & mentally challenged students of BUDS school are marketed in the name MUKULAM through Kudumbashree shelf space programme. The students are trained in manufacturing of detergent powders, cleaning loations, soaps, doormats, yoga mats etc. NULM city mission management Unit successfully intervened into this and the products are marketed through margin free shops in Eloor.

- 33 Individual SEP units were established in Eloor ULB under NULM SEP loan and 17 SEP are started from Linkage & RF which include autorikshaws, tea shops, stitching units etc.

Aachees Dress World



Aachees dress world was started in 2017 with 2 Lakh NULM loan from Union Bank of India, Manjummel Branch. The total project cost was Rs.4 Lakh. The beneficiary Mrs. Metilda James is earning a profit of Rs.3 Lakh annually.

- 38 NHGs were given interest subvention of Rs.70,911 through PAISA PORTAL for the linkage loans taken and Rs.2,97,563 was given manually as interest subsidy for those 32 SHGs taken linkage loans before 2018.

SUDHI WATER – RO PLANT



Eloor ULB has earmarked Rs.6 Lakhs in annual plan(2019-20) fund for Kudumbashree RO Plant .The 5 member women SHG has named the project as SUDHI Water. The group intends to supply purified drinking water in 20 litre cans to the market at subsidized rates ,without compromising in quality. Eloor Municipality provides 50 % financial assistance for setting up the plant, along with land and building for tenure of 10 years in profit sharing basis. The plant will start operation from April 2020 tentatively.

SUPPORT TO URBAN STREET VENDORS

Town Vending Committee was adjourned; ad hoc committee was formed at Eloor ULB for electing TVC members. Out of 58 Street vendors identified, 23 ID cards were distributed at Eloor..

- & 151 new NHGs were formed in Eloor ULB since 2017 under NULM.

58 students from Eloor ULB were enrolled since 2017 for different trainings, 24 were employed with minimum monthly salary of Rs.8000

- ULB has earmarked Rs.6 Lakhs in ULB plan fund to establish RO plant at Eloor. The women SHG group with 5 beneficiaries were formed. SEP G application has been given to Dena Bank, Eloor for SEP loan for the project. The RO plant will be functional by April 2020.
