

MINUTES OF THE PRM ON 11th JUNE 2018

PART A

- The cluster level coordinators (CLC) can be selected from NHG members as well owing to the fact that during the initial identification process qualified candidates were not available from the resource pool of JEVA and master farmers. New circular regarding this has to be issued without delay (Action: Aiswarya.V.A)
- All districts will have the freedom to procure passion fruit seedlings from neighboring districts or other sources for planting at an earlier date. However the cost of seedlings including transportation should not exceed Rs.15/vine. (Action: Rakhi.R)
- All the MKSP officers in charge should take necessary action to start cultivation in the identified and reported fallow land as per the PRM. This should reflect in the final area achievement. The JEVA honorarium mentioned as per the guidelines issued for the fallow less programme shall be modified to accommodate lands that were fallow above 5 years also. (Action: Aiswarya.V.A)
- The Paddy Procurement and Processing Fund (P.P.P.F.) guidelines will be modified in such a way that the fund maximum 2 lakhs can be sanctioned by the DMCs itself to the producer collectives to avoid inordinate delay. (Action: Rakhi.R)
- Since lack of awareness regarding the idea of producer companies exist among District level officers it was decided to organize an exposure visit to Madhya Pradesh during the month of September. (Action: Aiswarya.V.A)
- All DPMs directed to take photographs of the reported existing plant nurseries in district and reported to PO before 30th June. (Action: Rakhi.R)
- New incentive pattern for organic farming and medicinal plant cultivation is thought about for promoting such ventures pending GB approval. (Action: Aiswarya.V.A)
- All DMCs, MKSP ADMCs and MKSP DPMs are directed to check the accuracy and validity of data submitted by BCs before sending to state mission. (Action: All DMCs)
- All DMTs are requested to recheck the suggestions of agricultural commodities identified for PCs eg : Wayanad, Alappuzha, Kannur, Thiruvananthapuram and Idukki. (Action: MKSP ADMCs and DPMs))
- Kannur DMC shall be contacted to get the whereabouts of the existing high tech rice mill. (Action: Rakhi.R)
- All DPMs were given the assignment of identifying and establishing any two initiatives with latest agricultural technologies/Innovations/ unique ideas and present on July 20th.
- Good names need to be suggested for agri fests and plant nurseries. (Action: Athira.M.S)
- Agri fests should be included in the AAP as an additional programme for financial inclusion. (Action: Athira.M.S)
- PO should list out the topics for latest technological innovations that can be adopted and forwarded to DPMs. (Action: Dathan.C.S)

- As per SFAC project proposal, Kozhikode and Malappuram has to identify 5 value addition units in coconut each and 1 CFC each (Action: Rakhi.R)
