Livelihood Survey

As a part of post flood activity to rebuild Kerala in August 2018, a livelihood survey was conducted on 28th & 29th Oct 2018.

Aim of the survey is to assess occupational gap in post flood situation and identify the preferred sectors for livelihood.

13012 people were surveyed

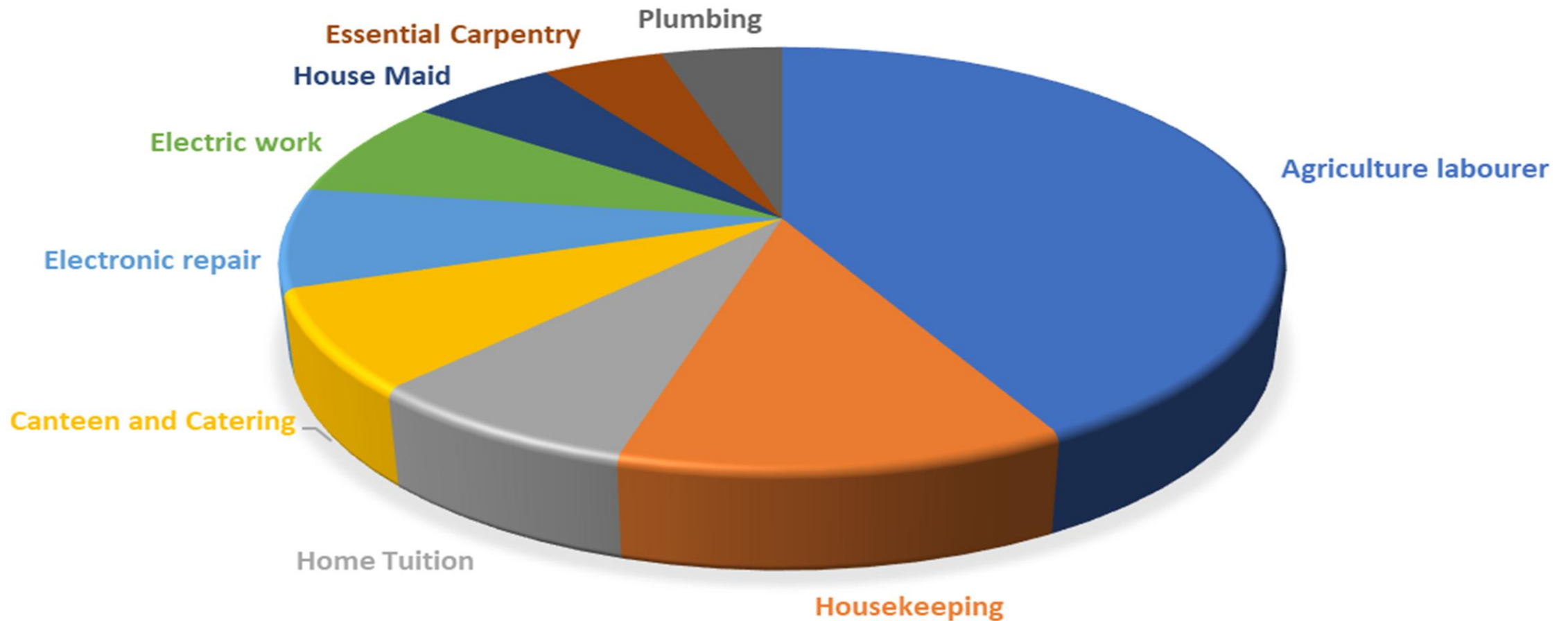
ARISE training focuses on preferred sector identified therein.

Survey Findings

Total Respondents – 13012
Presently Unemployed – 7851

OCCUPATIONAL GAP IDENTIFIED

Respondents requiring skilling for livelihoods
Entrepreneurship and Wage
Employment (Non farm) – 4610 (58.9%)
41.1% opted for farm based Livelihoods

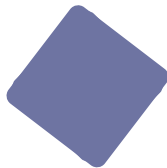

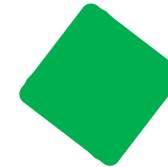
Based on survey findings it is proposed to provide skilling to 50000 youth and women across the state for Livelihoods as a major strategy

Started from Dec 15th 2018



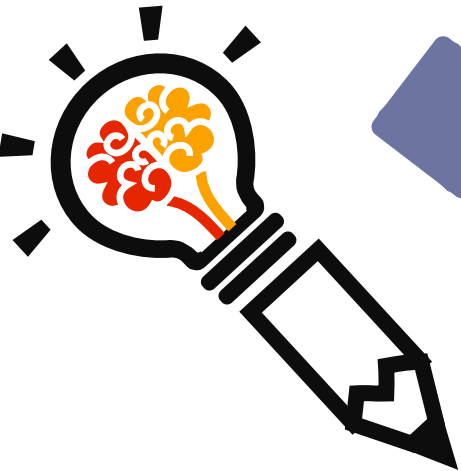
Focussed on forming Multi Task teams in Technical sector

RKDP Proposal

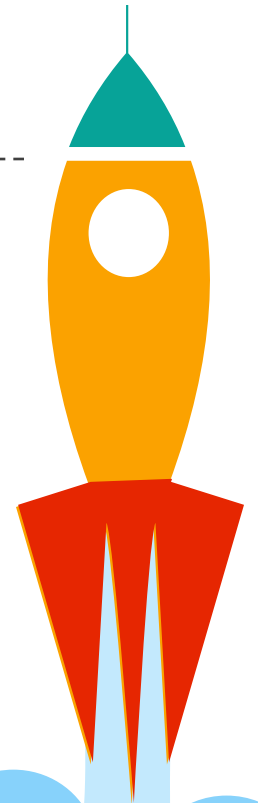
To provide **skill training for 10,000 candidates**



Formation of Multi task teams in all LSGs by providing skill training in Technical sectors.



Fund for Skill training to **10000 @10000=10 Cr.**



ARISE- Status

- ARISE Skill Trainings in 10 specific sector to ensure livelihood opportunity post flood commenced in Jan 2019
- A concerted effort throughout Kerala was taken up and 512 batches could be completed till March 2020.
- Further it was discontinued due to pandemic and lockdown restrictions.
- State plan fund allotted for Special Livelihood and fund for GOT and Skill training(NRLM) was utilized for ARISE training.
- Rs 5Cr and Rs 3Cr respectively was utilized from state and NRLM fund. This could benefit 14000 candidates in getting trained in a suitable livelihood activity
- As RKDP fund was received only in march 2020, the trainings could not be done as planned due to restrictions of pandemic
