

Place of visit: Kanhangad & Nileswaram Municipality, Kasargod

Date of visit : 18, November, 2017

Purpose of visit: Kudumbashree School; supportive monitoring visit to Neighbourhood Groups (NHGs), Kasargod district.

Persons met: Chairman and elected representative of Kanhangad and Nilesweram Municipality, District mission team, CDS, ADS Neighbourhood Groups members (NHGs) and NULM City Mission team.



As a representative from the state mission to provide technical and monitoring support in the 'Kudumbashree School' initiatives at various NHGs within the district. Activities under Kudumbashree School have been progressing in all NHGs as envisaged. NULM activities in two cities of the district namely Kanhangad and Nilesweram are reportedly on its right disrection.

Review of NULM activities of Nileswaram municipality	Implementation of NULM core components like SEP and ESTP are not as desired. Space is available for CLC, but does not have required space; as per guideline.	Concerted efforts are to be made for achieving the targets in ESTP & SEP. CMM has to submit a detailed proposal for establishing CLC.
Kudumbashree School under Nileswar CDS. Haritham NHG, ward 8, Asha NHG, Ward 15 & NANma NHG, Ward 25	Active participation of NHG members were visible in all NHGs. (18 out of 20 members were present in Haritham group; all 17 & 18 members were present in Asha and Nanma group respectively. Session on organization helped a lot to understand and to follow the systems of an organization/ society/ group like the proceedings of the meeting how to write agenda, minutes, decisions etc.	All 3 SHGs visited have completed four chapters of the module given. The mode/ method of teaching adopted are discussion and group activities; which was found very much useful to understand the topic taught or discussed.

Place of visit: Tirur and Tirurangadi Municipalities, Malappuram district

Date of visit : 20, November, 2017

Purpose of visit : Issuance of ID cards to eligible street vendors are pending in both the ULBs, due to some technical and political issues. Had discussions with various stakeholders concerned for completing the activities under NULM component, support to urban street vendors.

Persons met: Chairman, Standing committee (welfare), council members, Municipal secretary, CPO and other officials; CDS/ADS, representatives of trade union and City Mission Manger.

Conducted a meeting at Tirurangadi municipal office with Municipal Chairperson, Vice chairman, standing committee members, municipal secretary, CPO, municipal councilors, CMM, CDS etc	Issuance of ID cards got delayed due to technical reasons as the ULB does not have any space to accommodate the vendors in the street as the roads having heavy traffic in most times. Public spaces are not available to rehabilitate the street vendors. There is resistance from the authorized merchants since they are afraid of losing their business.	Discussed the provisions provided in the Street Vendors (protection of livelihoods and regulation of Street Vending) Act- 2014. It is the mandate of each municipality to do survey for identifying street vendors and to issue ID cards to all eligible vendors. ULB decided to issue ID cards on 29 th , November, 2017 after the TVC meeting scheduled for 27 th of this month.

There is resistance from the authorized merchants since they are afraid of losing their business. The appointment under NULM -for CMM/ MTP/CO-- is still pending and the ULB could not move further due to the non- availability of specialist staff under NULM.</p>	<p>Explained the provisions under the Street Vendors (protection of livelihoods and regulation of Street Vending) Act- 2014 that favors street vendors to get ID cards. It is the mandate of each municipality to do a systematic survey to identify street vendors; and to issue ID cards to all eligible vendors. ULB decided to issue ID cards provided if council approves the same.</p>
