Thodupuzha - Idukki District

Two residential training programmes viz; Architecture & Civil 2 D Drafting with Auto CAD and Assistant Surveyor are sanctioned at Thodupuzha to the Skill Training Provider (STP), M/s LIFE. Architecture & Civil 2 D Drafting with Auto CAD is one among the flagship course conducted under NULM with duration of 730 Hours. The agency has started this course with candidates from various cities. The second courses; assistant surveyor is yet to commence. In this circumstances, a visit was conducted to the training centres at Thodupuzha for monitoring the training process and inputs standards.

Two batches with a capacity of 70 candidates (35 each in a batch) are proceeding in Architecture & Civil 2 D Drafting with Auto CAD in Thodupuzha. During the visit to the centre, it was found that all the candidates are attending the course regularly. Though the copies of the participant guide were available with the trainers and the centre head, it is not yet distributed to the candidates. Audio facility was not installed in the surveillance system. Though it is an outsourced centre, two staff members of LIFE was present at the centre full time.

During the visit, interaction was held with the students, trainers, centre head and the STP officials. The candidates expressed their satisfaction on the facilities at the centre and hostel. The centre head and the STP official assured to rectify the defects in surveillance system within three days. They also assured to distribute the participants guide to all the candidates within 5 days, as it printing and supply will take this much of time. The STP officials informed that they have arranged another centre at Al-sar college of Engineering for the course – Assistant surveyor.

Thalassery – Kannur District

The city mission management Unit (CMMU) of Thalassery municipality organised a mobilisation camp under Employment through Skill Training and Placement

Component. The CMMU has requested for resource support for conducting the mobilisation camp. In addition, Human Arm, a society of skilled women promoted by Kudumbashree under NULM had submitted an e-tender to Malabar Cancer Centre (MCC) for supply of skilled manpower. The contract for supply of 40 skilled candidates in 4 job roles was awarded to this society. Humanarm had requested to provide 40 skilled candidates for placement in MCC. It was planned to recruit the candidates for placement at MCC from among the candidates enrolled for the same job roles in skill training. Thus a visit was conducted to Thalassery for facilitating the mobilisation camp.

The District Mission Coordinator, Kudumbashree Dr. Surjith inaugurated the mobilisation camp. After the inauguration, a detailed session on the courses available under NULM, eligibility for enrolment, job description for each course, available centres for the courses etc. was conducted. After the session, the candidates opted for the course- General Duty Assistant was screened so as to ensure commencement of training one 20th November, 2017. Thirty six candidates took admission for the General duty Assistant Course. The screening process ended by 4.00 Pm. After the mobilisation camp, a meeting was convened with Shri. NK Remesan, Chairman of Thalassery Municipality at municipal office.
