Component wise achievements as City Mission Manager in Kayamkulam Municipality	
1. Social Mobilization and Institution Development	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conducted Sparsham campaign to identify the urban families left out of Kudumbashree network and by follow up the data and a total of 1960 families are included in the Neighbourhood Group (NHG) network of Kudumbashree during 2017-2020 periods by forming 140 new NHGs. Also as a part of ‘Relationship Kerala’ 26 elderly NHGs and 4 PWD NHGs are formed during this period. • Identified 15 inactive NHG’s and manage to revive them during 2017-2020. • Assisted 193 SHGs to get revolving fund support of Rs.10000/- for each NHG from NULM Programme. • Assisted 44 Area Development Societies to get revolving fund support of Rs.50000 for each ADS from NULM Programme. Supported them to start income generation activities using the revolving fund. • Assisted 606 NHGs to get linkage loan from Banks and Linkage subsidy from NULM Programme • Grading of 146 non-graded NHGs identified through Sparsham campaign is completed 	
2. Employment through Skill Training and Placement	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Managed to enroll 307 unemployed youth from Kayamkulam Municipality in different skill training programmes (32 numbers of courses) under Employment through Skill Training and Placement (EST&P) component of NULM. Among them 159 passed the assessment and 113 of them are placed under wage employment. • Assisted in monitoring the performance quality of the Skill training providers (STP) of EST&P Programme started skill training Centres in Kayamkulam. Ascensive educare and Roomen technologies are the STPs monitored by the CMMU, Kayamkulam. • Conduct all mandatory visits during training to make sure that the training will complete in good quality. • Conducted skill gap analysis and submitted the report to the SMMU. Follow-up them and arranged interview for 6 students in two firms, out them two get shortlisted. 	

3. Self Employment Programme

- As a part of SEP component, technical assistance was provided to urban poor for setting up micro enterprise as part of livelihood generation.
- Assisted 46 individuals from Urban Poor Community to start micro enterprises (ME) using Bank Loans under Self Employment Programme of Day NULM. It includes 41 **individual micro-enterprises and one group enterprise**. A total of Rs.59, 94,000/- is arranged as bank loan for these ME units.
- There are a total of **120 ME units** of urban poor from Kayamkulam Municipality were established using the fund from SHG/ADS Revolving fund, Thrift Loan and linkage loan.
- **Santhwanam** project has been established (1 Unit) and provide service in Municipal office and other Govt: offices and earning above Rs 10000/- per month.
- Manage to mobilize beneficiary for **Harsham Geriatric care** and provided placement for the skilled beneficiary.
- Identified 4 individuals from the ULB, skilled for Electrician/Plumbing Training. **Multi Task team** will start functioning by March 2020.
- Two **Nano markets** were established in All-Fresh and Lamcy Supermarkets for the marketing of Kudumbashree products.
- Organized 2 **food fests** (Payasa Mela) in the ULB area and 2 Kudumbashree Units participated.
- Mobilized and formed **Construction Unit** of 16 Kudumbashree members and completed a house for PMAY beneficiary in the ULB.
- Assisted 30 entrepreneurs to attend the EDP Training.
- Provided skill training for 20 Kudumbashree beneficiaries on Cloth bag and provided sewing machine for them through Dist: Mission (Save the Children Project), and started 3 cloth bag units.
- Managed to identify number of Kudumbashree products and forwarded to state mission, to be market through Amazon.

4. Support for Urban Street Vendors

- Assisted ULB in setting up the Town Vending Committee as part of the implementation of Street Vendors Act-2014 and assist City Project Officer to convene meetings of the Committee.
- Assisted ULB to conduct the survey of Street vendors in Kayamkulam Municipal Area.
- Assisted ULB/ Town Vending Committee to recognize 204 Street Vendors identified through survey and managed to distribute 42 ID cards.
- Managed to bring all women street vendors under Kudumbashree network.

5. Shelter for Urban Homeless

- Conducted survey regarding the details of the shelters available on Kayamkulam ULB area.
- Conducted geo- tag of the shelters in the ULB area.

6. Other Achievements

- Actively involved in the implementation of campaigns like Kudumbashree School, Neetham, Sparsham, etc.
- Undergone three days Integrated Capacity Development Programme for NULM Functionaries by the Centre For Environment And Development (CED), Thozhuvancode, Vattiyurkavu, Thiruvananthapuram
- Undergone two days Plan Project Implementation Training Programme organized by KILA @ Alappuzha.
- Attended two days Training Programme for CDS Chairpersons on NULM Programme Implementation organized by State Mission Management Unit at Mariya Rani Centre, Thiruvananthapuram
- Attended one day training programme on the implementation of PFMS by NMMU at State Mission Trivandrum.
