Purpose of visit: to attend the review meeting

Work under taken : A review meeting of all the urban missions under the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs , was held on 3rd October 2017 at Kochi by the Secretary and Joint secretary, MoHUA , GoI. and Principal Secretary, LSGD, GoK. The programme commenced with a welcome speech by Sri. TK Jose, Principal Secretary, LSGD.

The following are the major observations and decisions taken on **Deendayal Anthodaya Yojana - National Urban Livelihoods Mission**, during the review.

ULB Visited: Nedumangadu Municipality

Purpose of visit: To supervise the Block Co-ordinator's examination held at the Govt. HSS Aanad , Nedumangadu.

Work under taken: Block coordinators selection was held under the NRLM programme. A written examination was held on 14th of October for both the post. Block coordinator 1 and block coordinator 2. The HSS, Anad was chosen as the venue of the written test. Reached the venue at 9 am supervised the arrangements. It seems that the school team is very much experienced in conducting such written examinations, as the school being a permanent venue of all PSC tests. The school staff team under the leadership of its principal and the DMC, Trivandrum made all the necessary arrangements, well in advance. The question papers bundles' were examined for any tampering and distribute during the start of the examination. In the morning BC1 was held and it was assured that only the BC1 questions are distributed during morning. Total persons applied for the pots – 889 and the number attended the test – 564

Once the test got over in the morning evaluation of the test was held. The teaching staff of the school did that job.

The BC2 examination held in the afternoon attended by 330, number applied is 418.

It was observed that the school authorities were well prepared and their experience in the field of conduct of the examination was very much evident. There were no complaints raised by the applicant.
