| Conducted a meeting to review the performance made under different NULM components in each ULBs | Mobilization of candidates to the EST&P component is satisfactory in most ULBs. However, CMMs may take serious efforts to achieve the targets under SEP components. Urban service team and urban service sector enterprises need to be focused. Based on the survey findings, there is a need of six new shelter homes in Kozhikode and one each at Koyilandy and Vatakara municipality | Monitoring of training agencies by CMMU has to be intensified. CMMU including Cos have to take responsibility in mobilizing potential candidates for skill training. Potential entrepreneurs are to be identified in all ULBs for urban service sector enterprises. New DPR for the construction of shelter homes have to developed from Kozhikode, Vatakara and Koyilandy ULBs Action to be taken to issue ID cards to all eligible street vendors. |
